



## A

“Shall the Western Dubuque County Community School District be authorized to participate in an Instructional Support Program for a period of five years beginning with the district’s 2002-2003 budget year on July 1, 2002. The Instructional Support Program will be funded by State Aid, property tax and a local state income surtax. The annual mix of property tax and state income surtax (such surtax not to exceed 4%) will be determined by the Board of Education. Funding for the program shall not exceed 8% of Western Dubuque School’s annual regular program district cost. The Instructional Support Program property tax assessment will start with the 2002-2003 budget year and the state income surtax will begin for taxes paid in calendar year 2002. The state income surtax will be paid by all persons who are legal residents of the school district on December 31<sup>st</sup> of each calendar year and are required to pay state income taxes.”
