





CITY OF ASBURY

Mayor - four year term: **Jim Adams** received 105 votes and was declared elected. Scattering received 12 votes.

Two members of City Council - four year terms: **Robert L. Reisch** received 118 votes, **Larry Nagle** received 33 votes, and were declared elected. Joe Oberbroeckling received 3 votes, and scattering received 19 votes.

143 votes were cast in Asbury. 3,756 eligible 7 absentee

CITY OF BALLTOWN

Mayor - two year term: **Sherri Sigwarth** received 19 votes and was declared elected.

Five members of the City Council - two year terms: **Shelli Schmitt** received 18 votes, **Pete Dupont** received 17, **Andy Wilwert** received 16, **Herb Sigwarth** received 12 and **Hillary Koetz** received 6 votes and all five were declared elected; Lisa Klinkhammer received 4 votes, Loras Mauer and Shannon Brimeyer each received 3 votes, and scattering received 13 votes.

18 votes were cast in Balltown. 51 Eligible 1 absentee

CITY OF BANKSTON

Mayor - four year term: **Rick Stoffel** received 3 votes and was declared elected.

Three members of the City Council - four year terms: **Sherry Gotto** received 3 votes, **Joe Gotto** received 3 votes, and **Joe Davidshofer** received 3 votes and all three were declared elected.

3 votes were cast in Bankston. 21 Eligible 0 Absentee

CITY OF BERNARD

Mayor - two year term: **Rick McDonnell** received 25 votes and was declared elected; Jim Fisher received 2 votes and Randy Roling received 1 vote.

Two members of the City Council - four year terms: **Linda Roling** received 18 votes and was declared elected. **Jessica Ries** received 14 votes and **Janine Capesius** received 14 votes and are tied for 2nd. The Board of Supervisors drew lots and **Janie Capesius** was declared elected as the 2nd council member; Lindsay Engling received 8 votes.

30 votes were cast in Bernard. 75 eligible 1 Absentee

CITY OF CASCADE

Mayor - two year term: **Marcus Behnken** received 201 votes and was declared elected; Pat Kearney received 8 votes and scattering received 22 votes.

Two members of the City Council - four year terms: **Pat Kearney** received 229 votes, **Steven J. Knepper** received 283 votes and were declared elected. Merlin J. McDermott received 177 votes and scattering received 10 votes.

370 votes were cast in Cascade. 1,456 eligible 18 Absentee

CITY OF CENTRALIA

Mayor - two year term: **Jean Wuertzer** received 8 votes and was declared elected. Tim Then received 2 votes, and Randy Locklyn, Elizabeth Then, Tim Then, and Steve Thul all received 1 vote.

Five members of the City Council - two year terms: **Chris S. Clausen** received 12 votes, **Judith Murphy** 11 votes, **Verdus Petsche** 10 votes, **Mary Ann Reimer** 10 votes, and **Steve Thul** received 13 votes and all five were declared elected. Tanya Thul received 2 votes. Scattering received 3 votes.

10 votes were cast in Centralia. 100 eligible 3 absentees

CITY OF DUBUQUE

One member of the City Council at large - four year term: **David Resnick** received 2,796 votes and was declared elected. Scattering 125 votes.

One member of the City Council Ward Two - four year term: **Luis Del Toro** received 740 votes and was declared elected. Karla Braig received 277 votes and scattering received 2 votes.

One member of the City Council Ward Four - four year term: **Jake Rios** received 550 votes and was declared elected. Lynn V. Sutton received 311 votes. Scattering received 5 votes.

2,637 Votes were cast in Dubuque 39,764 eligible 489 Absentee

CITY OF DURANGO

Mayor - two year term: **Brian Martin Hoffman** received 9 votes and was declared elected.

Two members of the City Council - four year terms: **Karen Wold** received 9 votes, **Richard Wold** received 9 votes, and were declared elected.

9 votes were cast in Durango. 16 eligible 0 Absentee

CITY OF DYERSVILLE

Mayor - four year term: **Daniel J. Willenborg** received 1,039 votes and was declared elected. Alvin H. Haas received 513, Eugene Fangman received 7 votes and scattering received 5 votes.

One member of the City Council at large - four year term: **Mark Breitbach** received 1,063 votes and was declared elected. Michael Mullis received 493 votes, and Patty Kramer received 7 votes. Scattering 1 vote.

One member of the City Council Ward Two - four year term: **Michael J. English** received 291 votes and was declared elected. Patty Kramer received 119 votes and scattering received 9 votes.

1,382 Votes were cast in Dyersville 2,940 eligible 190 Absentee

CITY OF EPWORTH

Mayor- four year term - **Sandy Gassman** received 99 and was declared elected. Jim Gibbs received 2 votes, and scattering received 5 votes.

Two members of the City Council - four year terms: **Dana Nadermann** received 90 votes, **Jacob Reuter** received 70 votes and were declared elected. Rob Hosch received 44 votes, Mindy McDermott received 2 votes and scattering received 9 votes.

One member of City Council - two year unexpired term: **Karen Conrad** received 99 votes and was declared elected. Rob Hosch received 7 votes. Scattering received 3 votes.

116 votes were cast in Epworth. 1,242 eligible 3 Absentee

CITY OF FARLEY

Three members of the City Council - four year terms: **Marin E. Benda** received 76 votes; **David Kluesner** received 86 votes and **Jim Sweeney** received 19 votes and were declared elected. Bill Einwalter received 15 votes, Craig Breitbach received 12 votes and Amy Steffen received 4 votes.

94 votes were cast in Farley. 984 eligible 0 Absentee

CITY OF GRAF

Mayor - two year term: **Alicia Soppe** received 6 votes and was declared elected. Laurie Skattum received 4 votes and Thomas Hefel and Brian Jones received 3 votes each. Scattering received 5 votes.

Three members of the City Council - two year terms: **Bob Schilling** received 17 votes, **Jeff Schilling** received 13 votes, **Tom Hefel** received 6 and all were declared elected. Olin Skattum received 5 votes, Bryon Schueller received 4 votes, Sherry Breitbach, Jamie Long, Dan Mayne, and Richard Soppe all received 3 votes each. Scattering received 9 votes.

10 votes were cast in Graf. 52 eligible. 12 Absentee

CITY OF HOLY CROSS

Three members of the City Council - four year terms: **Dan Wilwert** received 40 votes, and **Ed Errthum** received 39 votes, **Tom Roling** received 12 votes and were declared elected. Mark Brehm received 5 votes and Kevin Neuman received 5 votes; Jeane Hess and Pat Maiers received 4 votes each and scattering received 34 votes.

50 votes were cast in Holy Cross. 244 eligible 0 Absentee

CITY OF LUXEMBURG

Mayor - two year term: **Roger J. Oberbroeckling** received 26 votes and was declared elected.

Two members of the City Council - Four year terms: **David Rueber** received 26 votes, **Michael Ungs** received 27 votes and were declared elected.

26 votes were cast in Luxemburg. 178 eligible 1 Absentee

CITY OF NEW VIENNA

Mayor - two year term: **Pat Hermsen** received 34 votes and was declared elected. Mike Lehman received 4 votes, Liz Meyer received 3 votes, Roger Langel, Ken Meyer, and Andy Willenborg all received 2 votes each and scattering received 3 votes.

Three members of the City Council - four year terms: **Diane Knepper** received 40 votes and **Ken Meyer** received 52 votes, and **James O. Naber** received 46 votes and were declared elected. Scattering received 8 votes.

55 votes were cast in New Vienna. 295 Eligible 5 Absentee

CITY OF PEOSTA

Two members of the City Council - four year term: **Gerald Hess** received 71 votes, **Carla Reuter** received 72 votes and were declared elected. Steve Gremmel received 63 votes, Kent Krause received 2 votes, and Ryan Hess, Jim Merten, and Dennis VanCleve all received 1 vote each.

111 votes were cast in Peosta. 931 eligible 13 Absentee

CITY OF RICKARDSVILLE

Mayor - two year term: **Daniel H. Doelz** received 20 votes and was declared elected. Steve Cleary received 3 votes.

Three members of the City Council - four year terms: **David Ernzen** received 18 votes, **Chris Errthum** received 21, **Amber Specht** received 21 votes and were declared elected. Steve Cleary received 3 votes.

23 votes were cast in Rickardsville. 148 eligible 0 absentee

CITY OF SAGEVILLE

Mayor - two year term: **Donald Recker** received 14 votes and was declared elected. Wayne Kennicker received 2 votes and Jim Specht received 1 vote.

Three members of the City Council - four year term: **Allen Bahl** received 14 votes and **Ruth M. Esser-Recker** received 13 votes, **Cheryl A. Specht** received 14 votes and were declared elected. Jacob Kennicker and Stacy Sabers each received 1 vote.

16 votes were cast in Sageville. 70 eligible 1 Absentee

CITY OF SHERRILL

Mayor -two year term - **David Beringer** received 23 votes and was declared elected. Lindsey Schreiber received 2 votes and Marc Hansen and Tom McCarthy both received 1 vote each.

Two members of the City Council - four year terms: **Lindsey Schreiber** received 25 votes, and **Patsy Hefel** received 11 votes and were declared elected. Joe Schreiber received 3 votes and Toby (Marc) Hansen, Tom Spoerl and Dallas Tully all received 2 votes each. Scattering received 4 votes.

On Public Measure A: Whereas the City of Sherrill, Iowa presently has local option sales tax providing for the proceeds to be allocated seventy-five (75) percent for property tax relief, twenty (20) percent for sewer, and five (5) percent for park. The City Council wishes to change the allocation to provide for twenty-five (25) percent for park, and seventy-five (75) percent for tax relief. If approved the change is to go into effect on January 1, 2016.

There were 20 votes in favor and 9 votes opposed. The public measure was declared **APPROVED**

30 votes were cast in Sherrill. 128 Eligible 0 absentee

CITY OF WORTHINGTON

Mayor - two year term: **William H. Burger** received 32 votes and was declared elected. Eldon Jaeger received 5 votes and Tom Marbach received 1 vote.

Two members of the City Council - four year terms: **Kay Risser** received 29, **Dan Feldmann** received 18 votes and were declared elected. Lloyd Manternach received 10 votes, Eldon Jaeger received 5 votes and Darryl Ostwinkle received 3 votes. Scattering received 8 votes.

38 votes were cast in Worthington. 244 Eligible 0 absentee

CITY OF ZWINGLE

Mayor - two year term: **Russ L. Ryan** received 19 votes and was declared elected. Kerry Reisen received 2 votes. Scattering received 5 votes.

Five members of the City Council - two year terms: **Diana Freisinger** received 22 votes, **James Hoerner** received 19 votes, **John Marcus** received 16 votes, **Michael Petche** received 21, and were declared elected. **Joan M. Kunde and Jodi Kunde** both received 15 votes and are tied for the 5th place. The Board of Supervisors drew lots and **Joan M. Kunde** was declared as the 5th council member. Kerry Reisen received 2 votes. Scattering received 4 votes.
