

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



CITY OF ASBURY

Three members of City Council - four year terms: **Robert Blok** received 432 votes, **Bob Reisch** 434 votes, **Deborah Roth** 437 votes and were declared elected. Five others received one vote each.

One Member of City Council - two year unexpired term: **Jim Adams** received 346 votes and was declared elected. Scott Rasusch received 291 votes and scattering received five votes.

On the public measure B "Shall the City of Asbury in Dubuque County, Iowa, State of Iowa, be authorized to establish a Municipal Utility to provide communications services, including, but not limited to: television services, internet access services, local exchange telephone services and long distance telephone services there were four hundred thirteen (413) votes cast in favor of the public measure and two hundred fifty-nine opposed. The public measure was declared APPROVED.
676 votes were cast in Asbury. 2,377 eligible 10 absentee

CITY OF BALLTOWN

Mayor - two year term: **Herb Sigwarth** received 18 votes and was declared elected.

Five members of the City Council - two year terms: **Leon Cummer** received 14 votes, **Pete Dupont** received 16, **Bill Rettenmeier** received 14 and **Gerald Sahn** received 18, and **Ron Schmitt** received 13 and all five were declared elected; Dennis Hoppenworth received five votes, Harlan Pothoff received four and five others shared a total of 6 votes.

18 votes were cast in Balltown. 50 Eligible

CITY OF BANKSTON

Mayor - two year term: **Richard Stoffel** received 6 votes and was declared elected. Gerald Thier received two and Sherry Gotto one vote.

Five members of the City Council - two year terms: **Joe Gotto** received nine, **Sherry Gotto** received seven votes, **Joe Davidshofer** received eight votes **Gerald Thier** received four and **Walter Heisler** received three votes and all five were declared elected. Terry Gotto received two votes, Charles Vaske, Rose Mary Kruse, Richard Stoffel and Joyce Davidshofer each received one vote.

On the Public Measure B- "Shall the number of council persons for the City of Bankston, Iowa be reduced from five to three members? The change shall become effective on January 1, 2008." There was eight votes in favor and one vote opposed. The public Measure was declared **APPROVED**.

On the Public Measure C - "Shall the term of office of the City of Bankston Mayor and City Council members be changed from two (2) year terms to four (4) year terms, which terms for Mayor and Council members shall run concurrently? The concurrent terms shall become effective on January 1, 2008." There were eight votes in favor and one vote opposed. The public measure was declared **APPROVED**

9 votes were cast in Bankston. 18 eligible

CITY OF BERNARD

Mayor - two year term: **Robert Kenneally** received 25 votes and was declared elected..

Three members of the City Council - four year terms: **Rory C. Becker** received 26 votes, **Patrick Hentges** received 24 votes, **Richard D. McDonnell** received 26 votes and were declared elected.

26 votes were cast in Bernard. 76 eligible 2 Absentee

CITY OF CASCADE

Mayor - two year term: **Rick Knepper** received 106 votes and was declared elected; Scattering received fourteen votes.

Three members of the City Council - four year terms: **Becky R. Dolphin** received 119 votes, **Steve Ben Leytem** received 112 votes, **Gregory Staner** received 110 votes and were declared elected. Scattering received 13 votes.

145 votes were cast in Cascade. 1,437 eligible 5 Absentee

CITY OF CENTRALIA

Mayor - two year term: **Jean Wuertzer** received 16 votes and was declared elected. Pam Lenz received three and Randy Laughlin one vote.

Five members of the City Council - two year terms: **Chris S. Clausen** received 20 votes, **Terry Corbett** 19 votes, **Verdus Petsche** 15 votes, **Randy J. Laughlin** 16 votes, and **Steve Thul** received 12 votes and were declared elected. Judy Murphy received eight votes

21 votes were cast in Centralia. 86 eligible

CITY OF DUBUQUE

Mayor - four year term: **Roy Buol** received six thousand eight hundred twenty-three votes and was declared elected. John Markham received six thousand three hundred thirty-two and scattering received 102 votes.

One member of the City Council at large - four year term: **Ric Jones** received seven thousand seven hundred thirty-three votes and was declared elected. Dan Nicholson received five thousand sixty-three. Scattering received fifty-three votes.

One member of the City Council Ward One - four year term: **Kevin Lynch** received two thousand four hundred forty-six and was declared elected. Andrew Koons received five hundred eleven votes and scattering received twenty-one votes.

One member of the City Council Ward Two - two year term: **Karla Glab Braig** received one thousand seven hundred twenty-one votes and was declared elected. Lou Oswald received one thousand six hundred thirty votes and scattering received fifteen votes.

One member of the City Council Ward Three - four year term: **Joyce E. Connors** received two thousand two hundred thirty-two votes and was declared elected. Scattering received thirty-seven votes.

On Public Measure A - "Shall the City of Dubuque, Iowa, be authorized to establish a municipal utility to provide communications services, including but not limited to local exchange telephone services, long distance telephone services, Internet access services, and television services?"

There were eight thousand two hundred ninety-three votes in favor and four thousand seven hundred thirty-two votes opposed. The public measure was declared **APPROVED**

On Public Measure E - Shall the following proposition be approved?

1. That the members of the Library Board of Trustees shall be appointed by the Mayor with the approval of the City Council.
2. As the terms of office of the board members expire, the Mayor, with approval of the Council, shall appoint successors, each of which shall hold office until his or her successor is appointed and qualified.
3. That all appointments, except to fill vacancies, to the Library Board of Trustees, shall be for four (4) years. Any Trustee serving on an unexpired term with more than four (4) years remaining, shall be allowed to serve the remaining portion of said term

There were six hundred twenty-one votes in favor and three hundred forty-one votes opposed. The public measure was declared **APPROVED**

Three members of the City Council - four year terms: **Jason Putz** received 202 votes, **Todd M. Kluesner** received 188 votes, **Garry A. Gansen** received 100 votes and were declared elected. Judy Callahan received 97 votes, Toby Hancock received 81, Julie Jansen received 41, Tom Gassman received 27 votes and scattering received eight votes.

264 votes were cast in Epworth. 1,136 eligible 8 Absentee

CITY OF FARLEY

Mayor- four year term - **William F. Einwalter** received one hundred thirty votes and was declared elected. Scattering received three votes.

Two members of the City Council - four year terms: **Jay R. Hefel** received 91 votes and **Joyce Jarding** received 98 votes and were declared elected. Scattering received four votes

One member of the City Council - two year term: **Jody Scherrman** received 122 votes and was declared elected. Scattering received one vote.

Mayor - four year term: **Brian Maiers** received 35 votes and was declared elected. Scattering received one vote.

Two members of the City Council - four year terms: **Mark Goedert** received 34 votes, and **Jim Behnke** received 33 votes and were declared elected. Scattering received three votes.
36 votes were cast in Holy Cross. 225 eligible

CITY OF LUXEMBURG

Mayor - two year term: **Roger J. Oberbroeckling** received 46 votes and was declared elected.

Three members of the City Council - Four year terms: **Kenneth Foxen** received 47 votes, **Helen Langel** received 44 votes, and **Richard Steffen** received 15 votes and were declared elected. Pat Steffen received 11 votes and scattering received two votes.
47 votes were cast in Luxemburg. 177 eligible 2 Absentee

CITY OF NEW VIENNA

Mayor - two year term: **Ronald Boeckenstedt** received 43 votes and was declared elected. Scattering received 21 votes.

Two members of the City Council - four year terms: **Allan Rettig** received 49 votes and **Roger Langel** received 48 votes and were declared elected. James Naber received 26 votes and scattering received six votes.

One member of the City Council - two year term : **James Naber** received 22 votes and was declared elected. Roger Langel received six, and scattering received 12 votes.

74 votes were cast in New Vienna. 288 Eligible 1 Absentee

CITY OF PEOSTA

Mayor - four year term: **James Weydert** received 101 votes and was declared elected. Scattering received 11 votes.

Three members of the City Council - four year term: **Ray Stephan** received 83 votes, **Dick Avenarius** received 77 votes and **Brian E. Recker** received 73 and were declared elected.

Two members of the City Council - two year terms: **Dennis McDonald** 73 votes and **Tom Ingles** received 67 votes and were declared elected. Larry Mescher received 67 votes and Robert J. Hachmann received 56 votes, and Scattering received seven votes. (The ties for 3rd and 5th were broken by drawing names at the canvas)

Two members of the City Council - four year terms: **Melvin Wilgenbusch** received 44 votes, **Cole Schmelzer** received 39 and were declared elected. Scattering received seven votes.
53 votes were cast in Rickardsville. 131 eligible 2 Absentee

CITY OF SAGEVILLE

Mayor - two year term: **Don Recker** received 21 votes and was declared elected. Pam Schueller received one vote.

Two members of the City Council - four year term: **Milton Eichman** received 21 votes and **James Sweeney** received 22 votes and were declared elected.

22 votes were cast in Sageville. 121 eligible 8 Absentee

CITY OF SHERRILL

Mayor -two year term - **David Beringer** received 34 votes and was declared elected. Scattering received two votes.

Three members of the City Council - four year terms: **Jim Decker** received 34 votes, **Robert Wiedenbach** received 33 votes and **Lelan Ambrosy** received 20 votes and were declared elected. Scattering received 11 votes

Two members of the City Council - two year terms: **Patricia Hefel** received 31 votes and **Robert Richter** received eight votes and were declared elected. Lelan Ambrosy received eight and scattering received eight votes.

36 votes were cast in Sherrill. 128 Eligible

CITY OF WORTHINGTON

Mayor - two year term: **Daniel Feldmann** received 32 votes and was declared elected. Paul Engler received 28 votes and Scattering received 11 votes. Feldmann refused to serve via letter of 11-14-05.

Three members of the City Council - four year terms: **Jean Polfer** received 40 votes, **Sue Burger** received 39, **Daniel Feldmann** received 38 and were declared elected. Jackie Welter-Mayne received 33 votes, Ron Leuchs received 28 votes and Scattering received 24 votes.

96 votes were cast in Worthington. 276 Eligible

CITY OF ZWINGLE

Mayor - two year term: **Russell Ryan** received 11 votes and was declared elected. Scattering received eight votes..

Five members of the City Council - two year terms: **James Hoerner** received 165votes, **Kerry Reisen** received 18 votes, **Eldon Manderscheid** received 16 votes and **Willis Saewert** received 14 votes and **Paul Taylor** received 9 votes and all five were declared elected. Scattering received 16 votes.

22 votes were cast in Zwingle. 61 Eligible 1 Absentee
