We therefore declare the public measure: Shall Northeast Iowa Community College (Merged Area 1) in the Counties of Allamakee, Bremer, Buchanan, Chickasaw, Clayton, Delaware, Dubuque, Fayette, Howard, Jackson, Jones, Mitchell and Winneshiek be authorized to renovate, erect and equip buildings at multiple campus locations and other enrollment locations, including classroom, laboratory, mechanical and shop upgrades, general facility rehabilitation and new building construction for use by the Community College, contract indebtedness therefor, and issue its school bonds in an amount not exceeding \$35,000,000 for these purposes is APPROVED.


