

VETERANS' AFFAIRS COMMISSION

The Commission consists of three persons, all of whom shall be honorably discharged people of the United States who served in the military or naval forces of the United States in any war, including the Korean Conflict between June 25, 1950 and January 31, 1955, both dates inclusive, and including the Vietnam Conflict at any time between August 5, 1964 and the order to cease hostilities. Said membership shall be at all times, as possible, be equally divided between men and women who served in the Golf War, Korean Conflict, Vietnam Conflict, World War I, and World War II. Terms are three years. Appointments are made by the Board of Supervisors. The Commission is responsible for determining who is entitled to relief from the Veterans' Affairs Fund. Relief is available to indigent veterans of the wars and conflicts named above and their wives, widows and minor children.
