

Stakeholders History:

- The process for the development of the County Management Plan or an amendment to the Plan shall involve various stakeholders in the process in a meaningful way. These stakeholders shall include, but not be limited to, consumers, family members, county officials, and providers (441-25.13(331)). The plan shall describe a detailed quality improvement process that provides for ongoing and periodic evaluation of the service system, and of the providers of services and supports in the system. The stakeholders shall be involved in the development and implementation of the quality assurance process and evaluation of the system with emphasis on consumer input (441-25.22 (331)).
- Letters were authorized on December 18, 1995 asking for participation on the Stakeholder Planning Committee. On January 15, 1996, the Planning Council appointed 15 participants with “the responsibility of establishing priorities for the new County Management Plan.”
 - Members comprised from County MH/MR/DD Advisory Committee, physician groups in the community, the Alliance for the Mentally Ill, the Retarded Citizens Association, the Mental Health Association, the United Labor Participation Committee, and the Dubuque Area Labor-Management Council.
- At a Stakeholder Planning Committee meeting for the 1996-1997 planning process on July 11, 1996 it was determined that the work group would now function in an ongoing advisory capacity to the Committee. Active Stakeholder participation continued to meet throughout the year so that improvements could be adopted as amendments to the current plan or components of the plan for the following year. (excerpt from “Major Changes to Dubuque County Management Plan FY 2000, dated 1/21/1999)
- At a Stakeholders’ meeting on November 21, 1996 a motion was made to add consumers to the Committee. The Dubuque County Board of Supervisors approved this request on January 21, 1997.
- In 2012, after the legislation passage of Senate File 2315, Dubuque County entered into a 28E agreement with eight other counties to form the MHDS of the East Central Region
