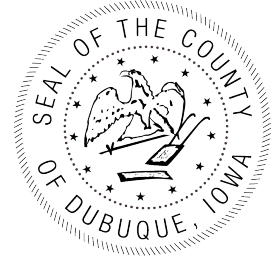

SHALL THE FOLLOWING PUBLIC
MEASURE BE ADOPTED?

Shall the County of Dubuque, State of Iowa, enter into a loan agreement and issue its general obligation bonds in an amount not exceeding \$40,000,000, for the purpose of improving and developing Dubuque County parks; improving existing recreational trails and developing new recreational trails; protecting sources of drinking water and the water quality of rivers and streams; protecting lands and providing natural floodwater storage to reduce flooding; and protecting wildlife habitat and natural areas, to be managed by the Dubuque County Conservation Board, with full public disclosure of all expenditures?
